The Camp

At 6 Points Creative Arts, participants are drawn together in a dynamic artistic community to experience camp, explore their passions, and improve their skills

- Located in West Chester, PA, just 25 miles west of Philadelphia, campers enjoy state-of-the-art Arts facilities, air-conditioned dorms, and 600 acres on the beautiful, green-certified campus of the Westtown School.
- Participants in grades 3-11 major in one Arts Discipline in which they are most passionate.
- 11th grade also participates in our *Gesher* Program a staff in training leadership experience designed to cultivate our next generation of CAA leaders. Participants have previously received different certifications such as Youth Mental Health First Aid Training.
- Campers from over 23 states across North America, Canada, and Europe attend for one, two, or three sessions, 12 days each.
- For campers staying multiple sessions, we offer intersession programming such as trips to Hershey Park, Valley Forge, Dorney Park, and more COVID protocols permitting.

The Program

In their chosen discipline, campers practice and perform in a dynamic, challenging and FUN environment. Participants set personal goals, increase skills, and work toward an on-site showcase, as well as portfolio/audition quality pieces.

- 2022 Arts Majors: Contemporary Theatre, Shakespeare, Creative Writing, Dance, Instrumental Music Ensemble, Musical Theatre, Photography, Visual Arts, Vocal Music Ensemble
- In addition to Majors, campers participate in Chugim (Electives) and Kinesthetic Arts (non-competitive sports) daily
- Judaism and The Arts intersect at every point of our program, from daily rituals to Arts Majors and dorm conversations to Shabbat.
- Jewish values are emphasized in the Arts studios and on dorm. Campers return home with a better understanding of how their Jewish
 identity coexists with their Artistic identity through a focus on our core values of yetzirah (creativity), sakranut (curiosity), ometz lev (grit),
 shiluv (collaboration), and m'lacha (craftsmanship), l'vchor (to choose).
- Campers participate in favorite camp activities like canoeing, cookouts, song sessions, Shabbat, and more!
- Creative Arts is a warm, welcoming community with a diverse campership and staff team representative of many levels of Jewish
 practice, gender identities and backgrounds.
- We are a member of the Foundation for Jewish Camp Incubator III cohort, generously funded by the Avi Chai and Jim Joseph Foundations.

The Staff

- Highly trained and highly skilled professional working artists lead each of our Arts Majors as Arts Mentors, focusing on skill development and performance.
- Passionate, nurturing, and well-trained college aged counselors work directly with campers in bunks and as assistant mentors in the Arts Majors.
- Experienced Rabbis, Cantors, and Educators join us each session to help bring the intersection of Judaism and the Arts to life.
- Licensed medical professionals serve our entire community's physical, mental, and social health.

The Facilities

- The facilities at the Westtown School, including beautifully landscaped grounds and stunning architecture, state of the art facilities, a pool, lake, ropes course and a working organic farm, make this an ideal home for our camp.
- Campers live in air-conditioned dorms, assigned by grade and gender identity. Dorm rooms house 2-3 campers and form a bunk with 4-5 other rooms.
- Westtown provides 24/7 security with shifts being staffed by two members of the Westtown security team, many of whom are EMTs.
- Westtown's dining staff work diligently and expertly, often conversing with CAA families directly, to ensure every child's dietary needs
 and restrictions are met.
- Nearly 40% of food prepared in the dining hall is sourced locally, including hundreds of pounds of produce directly from the Westtown farm where Culinary Arts campers spend time.
